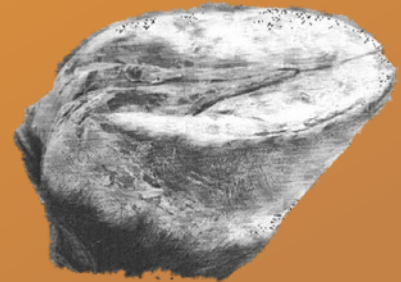


# NATURAL HOOF TRIM CLINIC

Hoof nipper  
Hoof stand  
Hoof knife sharpener

Nail puller  
Clinch cutter & farrier's driving hammer
